Any larger awards that are not collected on the day must then be collected from the office at a later date. If you would like your award collected by someone else, we MUST have permission from you beforehand for this. No awards will be given out without this, and there are no exceptions to this. The Gala dinner takes place at the Village Hotel, Dolomite Lane, Coventry Business Park, Coventry CV4 9GZ. There is also a train station within a 5-minute walk to the hotel, with regular trains from Birmingham and London. There is ample parking available at the hotel.
